- I. Location- Where something is.
 - A. Absolute Location- exact place on the Earth's surface.
 - 1. Latitude
 - 2. Longitude
 - B. Relative Location- location of a place based on its surroundings
- II. Place- Human and nonhuman features at a location.
 - A. Human- Examples: population or jobs people do. (many more)
 - B. Nonhuman- (Also known as physical features) Examples: landforms or climate
- III. Regions- Groups places based on similarities
 - A. At least one unifying feature such as:
 - 1. Human features- language or religion(many more)
 - 2. Physical features- mountains or climate(many more)
- IV. Movement- explains how people, goods, and ideas get from one place to another.
- V. Human- Environment-Interaction- (HEI)
 - A. humans impact their environment
 - B. Environment impacts Humans
