## Core Concepts 1.2- pgs. 6-7

- I. Location- Where something is.
  - A. Absolute Location- exact place on the Earth's surface.
    - 1. Latitude
    - 2. Longitude
  - B. Relative Location- location of a place based on its surroundings
- II. Place- human and nonhuman features at a location.
  - A. Human- Examples: population or jobs people do.
  - B. Nonhuman- (Also known as physical features) Examples: landforms and climates
- III. Regions- Groups places based on similarities with other places in the world
  - A. At least one unifying feature such as:
    - 1. Human features- religion, language, history (many more)
    - 2. Physical features- landforms, climates, vegetation (many more)
- IV. Movement- explains how people, goods, and ideas get from one place to another.
- V. Human Environment Interaction
  - A. Humans impact their environment
  - B. The environment impacts humans
